## StoryPlay

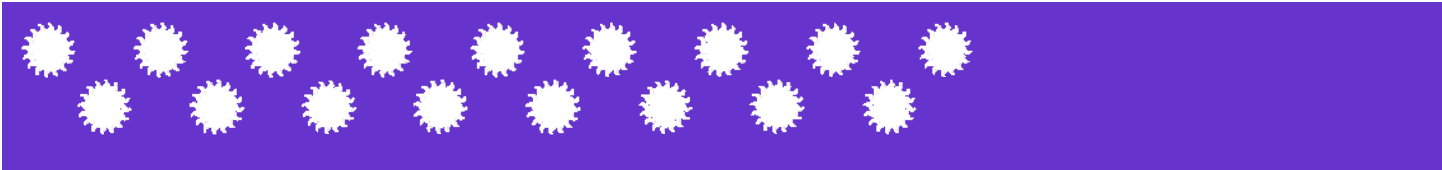
Miss Keri would like to remind everyone that StoryPlay will be taking the summer

## Chesapeake Therapeutic Riding

Since 2005, Chesapeake Therapeutic Riding has been providing horseback riding lessons and horse related activities for people with special needs in Harford County. CTR is located on Darlington Road in Havre de Grace.

In addition to therapeutic riding, CTR offers hippotherapy.

Hippotherapy is physical therapy on horseback, using the movement of the horse to facilitate improvements in the client.

Each session is conducted

by a licensed physical therapist, certified by the American Hippotherapy Association, and may be covered by health insurance.

CTR also offers Equine Assisted Psychotherapy (EAP) for clients seeking mental health services. Each session is conducted by a therapy team comprised of a mental health professional and equine specialist certified by the Equine

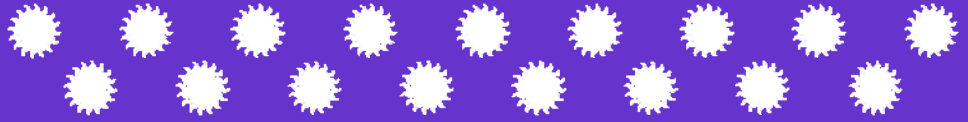
Assisted Growth and Learning Association (EAGALA). Since these sessions are conducted by a mental health professional, sessions may be covered by health insurance. EAP is proven effective to clients dealing with depression, substance abuse issues, ADD and other disorders. The broad based activities with the horses are designed for the client to experience self discovery on their healing journey.

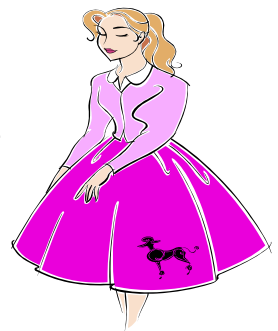
## Sock Hop
